

Computer Operating System: Windows XP

- 1. With Outlook Express open, click your cursor arrow on "Tools" from the menu bar and then select "Address Book..." from the resulting drop-down menu.
- 2. The Address Book Main Identity window will appear. Click on the "New" button and select "New Contact..." from the resulting drop-down menu.
- 3. The Properties window will appear. Enter all the information you want included with your vCard using the various tabs (Home, Business, etc).
- 4. When you have entered the relevant information, click on the "OK" button to save your changes.





- 4. When you have entered the relevant information, click on the "OK" button to save your changes.





Computer Operating System: Windows XP, Windows Vista, or Mac OS X

- 1. With Thunderbird open, click your cursor arrow on "Tools" from the menu bar and then select "Account Settings..." from the resulting drop-down menu.
- 2. The Account Settings window will appear. Click on your e-mail account and then click on the "Edit Card..." button.
- 3. The Edit vCard window will appear. Enter all the information you want included with your vCard using the various tabs (Contact, Address, etc).
- 4. When you have entered the relevant information, click on the "OK" button to save your changes.
- 5. The Account Settings window will reappear. Click on the "OK" button to close.





- 1. In Mail.app, open Address Book, go to the "File" menu and select "New Card" from the resulting drop-down menu.
- 2. A new empty card will appear. Fill in the information you want to include in the card in the labeled fields.
- 3. Click the blue highlighted "Edit" button when you are finished adding data to the card.

With Mozilla Thunderbird, you can send vCard attachments but the program doesn't allow you to import the contact information directly into your address book. However, the information shows up in the preview window so you can simply copy and paste the information into a new address book entry.

- When you receive a vCard in Mail.app, double click on its icon in the message or in the attachments pane.
- 2. Address Book will open and ask you if you are sure you want to add the card to the Address Book. Click "Add."
- 3. The new entry will now appear in the Address Book.
